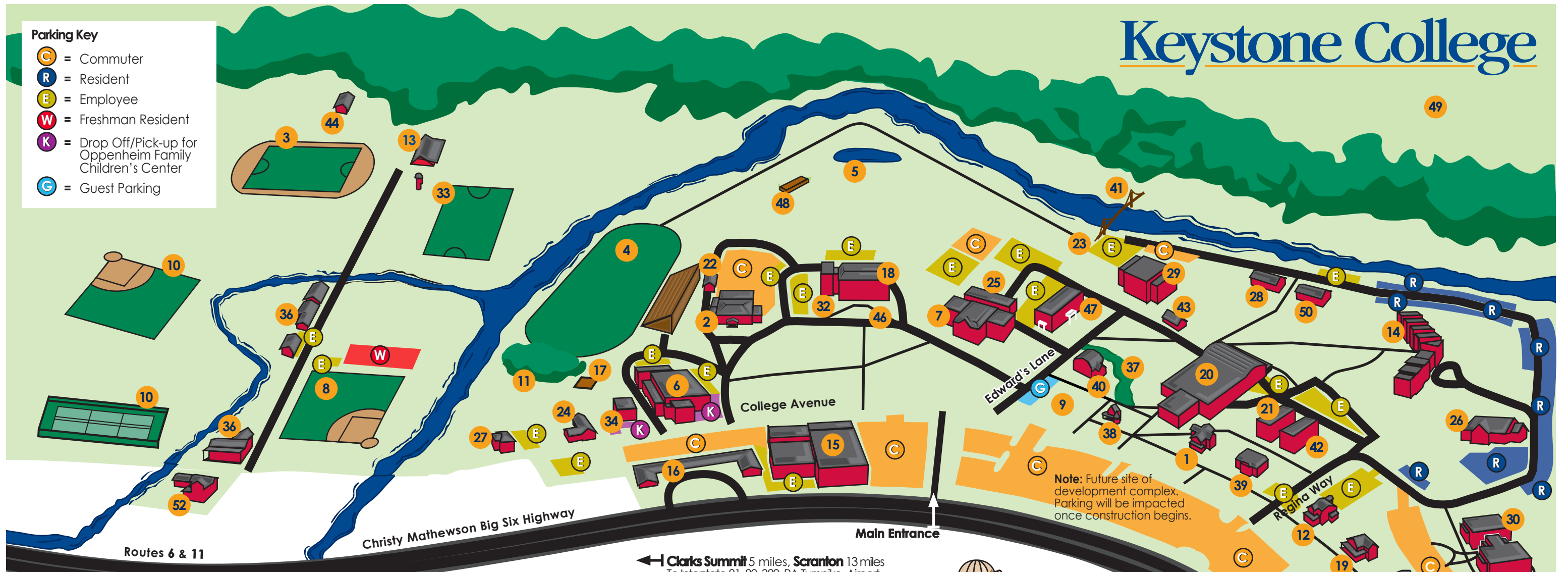


Keystone College
