We are pleased to announce that Keystone College will have a total of \$712,927 available for financial aid grants to students registered as full-time (greater than 12 credits within the traditional undergraduate program) that can be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance, or for emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus, including tuition, food, housing, healthcare and child care. This student population was selected to prioritize students with exceptional need, such as those who receive Pell Grants.
