

Student Health Requirements

Freshman/Transfer Students

- Emergency Contact and Immunization Form, Insurance form and TB Survey (forms will be available to complete on MyKC for new students one month prior to the start of the semester
- Access the <u>Student Portal</u> to complete all forms
- Please upload a copy of your Health Insurance Card, Front and Back
- Please complete all forms and Uploads NO LATER than July 15th for students starting in the fall semester and NO LATER than December 15th for students starting in the spring semester
 - ***If you will be a resident on campus, this MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO MOVING ON CAMPUS***
- A hard copy of your immunization record should also be submitted to the Student Health Coordinator

Immunization Requirements

- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis, Tetanus, (Tdap) within the last 10 years
- Meningococcal Meningitis A,C,Y,W-135
 - o If first dose was prior to age 16, a second dose is required

Pennsylvania State law requires all college students to receive information about meningitis/meningococcal disease and the vaccine, and to either receive the vaccine before coming to college or sign a waiver.

Student Athletes

- Per NCAA requirements, student athletes must include proof of sickle cell testing and results per NCAA requirements.
- Athletes who turn in vaccination forms to the athletic department, MUST still complete the information in the Student Health Portal

Student Health Portal

- Students who are registered for classes will have access to the Student Health Portal up to 30 days prior to the start of classes.
- The Student Health Portal can be assessed from <u>MyKC</u> or the Keystone College <u>Counseling and Well-Being</u> <u>Center page</u>.
- You will use the same username and password as your Keystone email and MyKC.
- Complete and submit all forms (please note some have a time limit of 15 minutes, please save your information periodically).
- Vaccinations MUST be entered into the portal manually. They can NOT be uploaded.
- Click 'document upload' and upload your insurance card
