



Summer is usually a time for teenagers to kick back, relax, and enjoy their time away from school. This wasn't the case for a group of nine ambitious students who participated in Keystone's Summer Undergraduate Research Experience (SURE).

Under the direction of Vicki Stanavitch '92, biology/chemistry instructor and laboratory supervisor, current or recently graduated high school students worked with Keystone students on a college-level research project.

The eight week, intensive program required approximately 30 hours per week,

including both laboratory and library research components.

"Not every college student gets a chance to do this type of research, let alone most high school students," Vicki said. "Here, the students are actually working with me on my own research, gaining useful lab experience. The program introduces students to the process of discovery and to a college campus environment, and encourages students to pursue studies and careers in the sciences."

### Intercollegiate Athletics Providing **Building Blocks**

Athletics is part of the mix of ingredients that give Keystone College its unique culture.

There is no doubt that athletics attract students. It helps increase enrollment, generates more enthusiasm in the campus community, and brings recognition to the institution. Through participating in athletics, students create and form long lasting memories.

Athletics participation is at its highest rate in the history of the College. The College currently sponsors 17 varsity sports and two club sports. Over 260 Keystone proudly call themselves student-athletes. This fall one in five students is involved in athletics with first-year students making up nearly half of these.

Student-athletes are an integral part of the student body, as athletics at Keystone College provides a well-rounded collegiate experience that involves a balance of academics, competitive athletics, and the opportunity to pursue a wide range of extra-curricular opportunities.

#### Success on the Field

Keystone athletic teams have enjoyed much success on the field, with many programs consistently contending for conference titles. In just the last three years, the baseball team captured three conference championships and the golf team two. As a result of those great accomplishments,

Student-athletes excel not only on the field, but also in the classroom. Since 2007, the grade point average of students participating in athletics has risen 10 percent. Stressing the Division III philosophy of education first, our studentathletes have been recognized by conference and national governing bodies for their educational accomplishments.

Balancing athletics and academic obligations is a tough challenge. However, many find time in their jam-packed schedules for a variety of extra curricular activities, such as participating in both on-campus and community-based programs and serving in campus leadership positions.

The success of the athletic programs has aided our student-athletes in continuing their athletic careers beyond college. Just in the past two years, five Keystone baseball players were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft, bringing great pride and recognition to the College.



In the past seven years, Keystone has added a variety of sports: men's and women's indoor/outdoor track and field, field hockey, and volleyball. This academic year will see junior varsity baseball added as another option.

To accommodate the growth in student-athletes and to the general student population, existing athletics facilities have been upgraded. The Larry Fornicola Fitness Center was recently renovated and features new weight-training equipment. A dedicated cardio room was also added to keep pace with the demand for fitness facilities.

### Phillip DelTorto '10: Expanding His Horizons

After countless hours of studying calculus, abstract algebra, and differential equations, Phillip DelTorto '10 never

expected to be teaching English as a second language. But that is exactly what the 2010 math education graduate is doing in Seoul, South Korea.

After spending a semester studying abroad in Barcelona, Spain, Phil was bitten by the travel bug. When a friend suggested putting his wanderlust to good use by teaching English

as a second language in South Korea, he was intrigued. After learning more about South Korea, particularly Seoul, Phil was sold.

"I really had a remarkable experience while studying abroad in Barcelona. I figured 'why not experience another culture?" Phil explains. "Seoul is such a clean and modern city; it is unlike anything I've ever experienced."

Although Phil isn't teaching math equations state-side as he initially envisioned his future, teaching English as a second language has proven to be a perfect fit.

"Keystone taught me to be a professional educator, not just a math teacher," Phil said. "With this opportunity, I'm able to combine my love for teaching and travel."

After submitting his resume to a number of schools, Phil received two job offers and ultimately accepted a position with Daechi Wonderland School, a private institute in the affluent Gangnam-Gu district in southeastern Seoul.

Phil teaches three English classes to Korean students. Two of the classes are with younger students and one with older, more advanced students. Since he has only been on the job for a short while now, Phil explains it is too early to see individual student improvement with his younger classes, but the teacher-student relationship is improving.

His class with the older students is a different story. "They are so much more advanced and speak such great English," Phil said. "Class is fun and we have interesting conversations about science and such."

The 22-year old Dalton, Pa., native is taking advantage of his opportunity and learning more about the Korean culture. "Everyone is very respectful and age is very important," Phil shared. "Coming from a small town, it is a new and challenging experience to live in Seoul."

Phil is also busy learning Hangul (Korean). "I am finding it rather easy to read Hangul, but speaking it is another story. I'm hoping some of my new Korean friends will help."

Phil is quick to point out that Keystone faculty and staff were instrumental in his journey. "Dr. Youyu Phillips, associate professor, sparked my interest in multicultural affairs and diversity," Phil said. "Shirley Michaels, study abroad coordinator, introduced me to traveling abroad and really encouraged me to spend a semester in Barcelona. She has been a big help throughout this entire process."

While he isn't sure if he wants to remain in Seoul, South Korea, Phil knows for sure he would like to continue teaching abroad in the future. "When living abroad, everything is an experience. Just going out to eat in a restaurant is a learning opportunity."

With his solid Keystone education, love for traveling, and open mind, who knows where you'll find Phil? He just might be teaching math back home in Dalton, Pa., or traveling the globe.

### Brad Higgins: at Home on the Range

After one conversation with Keystone College senior Brad Higgins, you quickly realize he's not the type of person who has any desire to pursue a nine-to-five office job.

Ever since he was a small child, Brad has loved nature and the environment and he's adamant about making his living in the great outdoors. There's no place that better fits that description than the wilds of Glacier National Park in northern Montana.

That's why Brad was right at home last summer during his two-month internship at the sprawling 1.4 million acre national park, where he worked on an important grizzly bear research project.

"It was really everything I expected it to be and more. I learned so much and had such a great experience," said Brad, who, not surprisingly, majors in environmental biology at Keystone.

Simply getting accepted as a summer intern at Glacier National Park was a major accomplishment. Competition for summer programs at national parks is fierce, and most students selected are actually college graduates pursuing master's degrees.

"I spent the summer before my junior year working for the Pennsylvania Game Commission so I knew I wanted to pursue an internship before my senior year. Dr. Skinner [Keystone Professor of Biology Dr. Jerry Skinner] alerted me about a job listing web site, www.fwjobs.com. I saw the job and applied for it. Fortunately, I was accepted. To be able to get something like this as a senior in college is really great and sort of puts me ahead of the game since most of the other people I worked with were graduate students."

During the summer, Brad would go on a rotation of nine days in the field and five days in camp. While in the field, he

traveled to various remote locations where he would live in a cabin or a tent.

He spent most of his time acquiring "bear rubs" or grizzly bear hair samples, which are collected from trees, poles, and fences.

The samples are then collected and analyzed to determine valuable information about the population of bears living within the study area, such as an estimate of size and genetics. The entire process provides critical information about the bear population inside the mammoth national park.

Brad was fortunate to receive assistance from Tim Eichner '97, former assistant director of the Keystone College Environmental Education Institute. Tim is now employed by the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation. He was generous enough to let Brad stay in his home in Kalispell, Mont., sparing him the expense of finding his own accommodations.

"When I wasn't working, Tim and I spent some time fishing and rafting. It was one more reason why the summer was so great," Brad said.

Besides the practical experience, Brad, son of Keystone Bookstore/Campus Shoppe employee Debbie Higgins, realizes the internship will help bolster his applications to prestigious wildlife biology master's degree programs such as the University of Montana and Penn State University.

After that, Brad, who is also a member of the Keystone baseball team, isn't sure where his journey will lead him as he pursues his education and professional career. But one thing is certain. He won't be working indoors.

### Dr. Tammy Barette: CSI on Campus

When Tammy Barette was a young girl in Lehighton, Pa., one of her favorite pastimes was putting together jigsaw puzzles. Her desire to use existing patterns to discover unknown pieces of information fascinated her.

So, it's not surprising that Dr. Barette makes her living these days teaching college students how to unravel mysteries of a different sort. Tammy is an associate professor of natural sciences at Keystone and coordinator of the College's forensic biology program.

"I'm a forensic anthropologist by trade," she said. "My job is to recover bodies and related evidence from crime scenes and try to use my knowledge of skeletal anatomy to identify the deceased and determine what may have happened to that person."

Tammy realized a career in forensic anthropology was her true calling while she was a student at Lehighton High School. After graduating from Indiana University of Pennsylvania with a bachelor's degree in anthropology, she went on to pursue a master's degree and doctorate in biological anthropology from The Ohio State University. Tammy also has a law degree from Ohio State and for two years operated her own law practice in Columbus.


But crime scene investigation and forensics anthropology is her real professional passion. She has served as a consultant to the Ohio State Police, the Columbus Police Department, and other law enforcement and government agencies in the state. She has worked on a variety of murder and missing person cases.

Tammy admits being called to the scene of an accident or murder may not be the most glamorous or pleasant profession in the world. But without experienced crime scene investigators and forensic professionals, many crimes would go unsolved, victims would go unidentified, and justice would be denied in many cases.

"When you are able to help a family by discovering what may have happened to a loved one, or identify a victim who otherwise might never be known, you are really having a positive impact. I think that's what helps motivate people in my profession."

She also knows that dealing with human tragedy can take a personal toll on anyone involved with law enforcement, forensics, or crime scene investigation.

"Of course, you can't see some of the things that we see and not have them affect you. That just wouldn't be possible. I think the best way to deal with those types of stresses is to maintain a healthy balance in your life, surrounding yourself with friends and family."



"What we offer at Keystone is more than just crime scene investigation. Our program offers a complete background in biology. Our graduates are prepared to pursue a variety of options when they leave here," she said.

Tammy is particularly proud of her students' success in the highly competitive annual International Association for



Identification (IAI) forensic competitions. During the last four years, the Keystone delegation has had three first place finishes and a third-place finish.

"I can't tell you how proud I am of our students, not just for their excellent performances in the IAI competitions, but for their overall dedication and expertise. Hopefully, they see my love of this profession and it has an impact on them now and in years to come."

## Keystone College Students: Working Toward Success

At first glance, Denise Gans-Torruellas has little in common with Alex Boirand and Jamie Ellis. Denise is a senior communications major from Columbus, Ohio, who hopes to pursue a career in technical writing after she graduates from Keystone in May. Alex and Jamie are sport management majors from the Isle of Wight, England, who are planning careers around their interest in athletics. Denise spends much of her time as a resident assistant in Hollinshead Hall on campus while Alex and Jamie are members of the Keystone soccer team.

Clearly, they are different people with different backgrounds and aspirations. But they share one important attribute. Not Denise, nor Alex, nor Jamie have any idea what it means to work *only* a 40-hour work week. Each weekday – and many weekends – they rise early, study or attend class, participate in extra-curricular activities, and hold down part-time on-campus jobs to help pay for their college education.

They lead lives that are, in many ways, the direct opposite of what many people perceive when considering the lifestyles of today's college students. All three say they are dedicated to doing their best because they were brought up to respect the principles of hard work and accomplishment.

They each believe the effort they put in now will lead to success in the months and years following their graduation from Keystone. And, there is also one other factor that drives each of them. They all need the money to help pay off the high cost of college education. Like many college students, working their way through school is simply something they have to do.

"Between classes, school projects, my duties as a resident assistant and other activities, I often put in 60-70 hour weeks," says Denise, admitting she doesn't keep track of her hours all that closely. "Some nights, I don't get to bed until after 2 in the morning. I try to get up at 8 a.m. everyday, but I have to admit I sometimes sleep in a little bit until 8:45 or so."

In addition to her duties as an RA, Denise works as an assistant at Keystone's Student Success Center, helping other students to acquire better study habits and techniques. She also works during summer breaks at home in Columbus. This past summer, she wrote promotional copy for a New York company specializing in on-line restaurant marketing, and she also worked at a retail store in Columbus.

Between federal grants and loans, Denise receives a generous financial aid package worth over \$16,000 per year. Nevertheless, she realizes the money she earns on her own helps reduce her overall financial burden.

"I have to work. It's that simple. I'm not from a wealthy family. Even with all my jobs, I'll still have tens of thousands of dollars in loans to repay," Denise says.

Denise's experience is hardly unique. Keystone College Director of Financial Assistance and Planning Ginger Kline reports that 92.8 percent of Keystone's 1,700 full and part-time students rely on financial aid to help pay for their education.

"Historically, many of our students are firstgeneration college students from middle-class families," Ginger says. "They have to use every possible means they can to pay for their education. They do that because a private college education has value to them."

Nationally, the average cost of college tuition and fees is \$26,273, according to the National Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators. At \$19,020 per year, Keystone's tuition and fees fall below the national norm. Keystone College finished 11th best in its category in the 2010 U.S. News & World Report rankings for the average amount of need-based financial aid awarded to its students. Keystone was ranked 14th in students graduating with the least amount of debt



and finished seventh in the economic diversity category, receiving recognition for the percentage of students receiving federal Pell grants.

Despite receiving financial assistance, working during the academic year and the summer is a way of life for many Keystone students. You won't find Alex or Jamie complaining about it one bit. Both young men receive a generous package of scholarships worth over \$16,000 per year, thanks to the outstanding generosity of several Keystone donors. But they still can't rely on those donations to meet their yearly expenses. They realize they need to work to contribute to their own education.

In addition to playing soccer, Alex works on campus for Sodexo, the international company that manages Keystone's facilities and dining services. He also assists athletic trainer Nicole Mosman and serves as an instructor for a fitness training class on campus. Between academic pursuits, playing soccer, and working, Alex said 60-hour work weeks are more the norm than the exception.

"I'm very proud of the fact that I'm not afraid to work hard," he says. "That's the way I was brought up and that's the way I live my life."

The same work ethic also applies to Jamie. Alex and Jamie had been friends for years in England and came to the United States together. Both are 24 and worked for two years prior to coming to Keystone.

Like his friend, Alex, Jamie's days often begin early in the morning and last long into the night. In addition to his academics, Jamie is also a member of the Keystone soccer team. He helps pay for his education by working in the Keystone student restaurant.

"I do whatever they ask me to do, mostly cleaning up and serving food," he says. "I don't mind having a lot to do," Jamie says. "Working hard keeps me on top of things. It's something I was taught from a very early age, and I know it will pay off down the road," he says.

Both Alex and Jamie are fortunate. They have already been offered employment as managers at a private soccer facility in York, Pa., after they graduate. They had been working there during summer vacations, and the company which owns the facility, UK Soccer, has agreed to hire them full time upon graduation. Both will use their salary to help pay off loans they have taken to pay for college.

"Being able to afford college has been a struggle and a lot of hard work. But people at Keystone have been terrific and I've really enjoyed it here. I know in the end, it will all be worth it."
