



Notice of Interim Measures

Anyone who reports sexual harassment or sexual misconduct is entitled to receive interim support and reasonable protection against further acts of misconduct, harassment, or retaliation as needed from Keystone College (“the College”). The College will provide these interim measures regardless of whether the complainant chooses to report to College Campus Safety or local law enforcement. Complainants in a sexual harassment or sexual misconduct case are entitled to interim support and protection, even if they were not the reporter.

The following interim measures are available through the College:

1. **No Contact Order** – An order issued by the College Campus Safety Office to the complainant and/or respondent banning all interaction and communication with the other party.
2. **Academic/Extracurricular/Transportation/Dining/Work/ Residence Arrangements** – A change in the relevant arrangements for the complainant or respondent to avoid contact between the two.
3. **Increased Security** – Increased monitoring, supervision, or security where the misconduct occurred.
4. **Interim suspension for the Respondent** – A temporary suspension of a respondent’s access to residence hall, campus, and activities if the respondent poses a threat to the normal operations of the College.
5. **Withdraw from Classes/Receive Academic Support Services** – If the College determines that the complainant’s academic performance may suffer due to the reported assault or harassment, allowance to withdraw from or retake classes without penalty and access to tutoring services.

A victim of sexual assault or sexual harassment has the right to report the crime to campus or local law enforcement regardless of whether he or she reports the crime to the College.
