Checklist:

- 2. Send official high school transcript or GED.
- 3. Send official college transcript if you have earned college credits.
- 3. Optional: Send SAT or ACT scores (Keystone's school code is SAT-2351 and ACT 3602). If received, test scores will be considered. Admissions may request test scores in some cases.
- 4. A letter of recommendation, teacher evaluation, or a personal statement about why you should be considered for admission to Keystone are not required, but highly recommended.

If you previously attended another college/university:

- 1. Contact Registrar's Office of all previous institutions for official transcripts to be sent to Keystone College, Admissions Office. If you earned fewer than 12 college credits, it is necessary to also submit an official high school transcript.
- 2. Transfer students intending to pursue a bachelor's degree in education with teaching certification and having earned a minimum of 36 credits at their previous institution must submit the official results of passing Praxis I/PECT.
- 3. If you previously attended Keystone College as a matriculating student, full-time or part-time, you may not need to complete the application. Please contact the Admissions Office to be formally readmitted.
