

## Freshman/Transfer Students

- Health History and Immunization Form

  - Upload: A copy of your immunization

record, and the front and back of your Health Insurance Card

 Access the Student Health Portal to complete all forms and Uploads NO LATER than 1 week prior to your first day on campus. If you will be a resident on campus this must be completed prior to moving to campus.

## **Athletes/International Students**

- Health History and Immunization Form
  - Authorization to Treat and Privacy
    - **Practices**
- Physical Exam completed within 1 year of your first day on campus
- Upload: A copy of your immunization record, physical exam, and the front and back of your Health Insurance Card.
- Access the Student Health Portal to complete all forms and Uploads NO LATER than 1 week prior to your first day on campus.

## **Immunization Requirements**

- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis, Tetanus, (Tdap) within the last 10 years
- Meningococcal Meningitis A,C,Y,W-135. If first dose prior to age 16 a second dose is required.

Pennsylvania State law requires all college students to receive information about meningitis/meningococcal disease and the vaccine, and to either receive the vaccine before coming to college, or sign a waiver.

## **Student Health Portal**

- Students who are registered for classes will have access to the Student Health Portal up to 90 days prior to the start of classes.
  - The Student Health Portal can be accessed thru the link on the current students page at keystone.edu, MyKC, or the Keystone College Health Services page.
    - You will use the same user name and password as your Keystone email and MyKC.
  - Complete and submit all forms (please note some forms have a time limit of 15 minutes, please save your information periodically).
    - Click 'document upload' and upload your immunizations, insurance card, and Physical (athletes/international students)
