Keystone Promise:

A pledge to every Keystone College student that within six months of graduating from Keystone College you will have received at least one job offer or been accepted into a transfer or graduate program.

This Report Measures Graduates Who:

- Secured full-time professional employment
- Secured part-time professional employment
- Were accepted into a graduate/transfer program (other than Keystone College)
- Returned to Keystone College for additional education/certification
- Accepted into advanced degree program at Keystone College
- Accepted into Law School
- Accepted into Veterinary School
- Accepted into Medical School
- Achieved other career goal
 - Those graduates were not seeking professional employment or acceptance into a graduate/transfer program
 - Another career goal may include entering into the military, volunteering, taking time off for family/personal reasons
- Not successful within 6 months of graduation

Methodology:

- Graduates who graduated 2018 – 2019 and/or attended Grad Finale were polled regarding their successes, via the Graduate Survey, developed by Institutional Research
- Follow-up emails were sent to individuals November 2019 in order to try to capture updated information
- Individual meetings were held with some graduates

Class Profile:

Number of Graduates:	252
Number of Survey Respondents:	247 (98%)

91% of the graduates who responded to the graduate survey secured professional full-time employment, professional part-time employment, were accepted into a graduate/transfer program, or achieved another career goal within 6 months of their graduation.

- 43% (105/247) secured professional full-time employment
- 5% (12/247) secured professional part-time employment
- 2% (4/247) secured other employment
- 1% (3/247) returned to Keystone College undergraduate programs
- 2% (6/247) enrolled in Keystone College graduate programs
- 0% (0/247) accepted into law school
- 1% (2/247) accepted into medical school (1)/veterinary school (1)
- 8% (21/247) accepted into other graduate schools
- 29% (71/247) achieved another career goal
- 9% (23/247) were not successful within 6 months of graduation

Master's Degree Graduates:

Number of Graduates:	10
Number of Respondents	8 (80%)

100% of the graduates who responded to the graduate survey secured professional full-time employment.

- 100% (8/8) secured full-time employment

Baccalaureate Degree Graduates:

Number of Graduates:	227
Number of Survey Respondents	227 (100%)

90% of the graduates who responded to the graduate survey secured professional full-time employment, professional part-time employment, were accepted into a graduate/transfer program, or achieved another career goal within 6 months of their graduation.

- 41% (93/227) secured professional full-time employment
- 3% (7/227) secured professional part-time employment
- 2% (4/227) secured other employment
- 1% (1/227) returned to Keystone College undergraduate programs
- 3% (6/227) enrolled in Keystone College graduate programs
- 0% (0/227) accepted into law school
- 1% (2/227) accepted into medical school (1)/veterinary school (1)
- 8% (21/227) accepted into other graduate schools
- 31% (71/227) achieved another career goal
- 10% (23/227) were not successful within 6 months of graduation

Associate Degree Graduates:

Number of Graduates:	14
Number of Respondents:	12 (86%)

100% of the graduates who responded to the graduate survey secured professional full-time employment, professional part-time employment, were accepted into a graduate/transfer program, or achieved another career goal within 6 months of their graduation.

- 33% (4/12) secured professional full-time employment
- 42% (5/12) secured professional part-time employment
- 17% (2/12) returned to Keystone College undergraduate programs
- 8% (1/12) accepted into another school
