

COVID-19 Protocols-Meals for Resident Students in Isolation and Quarantine

- Meals will be delivered once daily to a designated refrigerator for students in isolation.
- Director of Residence Life, Carlyle Hicks, and/or designee will notify Dining Services of the number of meals needed on a daily basis.
- Staff delivering food will be provided with face masks/coverings, face shields, gloves, garbage bags, cleaning spray, hand sanitizer, and paper towels.
- After picking up the meals from Dining Services, the staff delivering food will bring the meals to the designated refrigerator in isolation space. Staff will wear PPE and wipe down the refrigerator before and after placing the food in it.
- When they are finished, the paper towels and gloves will be placed in a garbage bag, which will be disposed of in a medical waste receptacle.
- Students in quarantine will have the option to have their food delivered to them following the same procedures as the students in isolation, or to pick up their meals once daily from a designated location in the Hibbard Campus Center.
- Students are expected to wear masks for the entire time that they are outside of their room.
- The meal pick-up location for students in quarantine has an outside entrance and is separate from the rest of the building.
- Students' meals will be labeled with a designated number, to protect their identities. The Director of Residence Life, Carlyle Hicks, and/or designee will label the meals with the designated numbers.
- When picking up their meals, students are expected to wipe down the door of the refrigerator before and after picking up their food. They are also expected to use hand sanitizer after touching door handles and the refrigerator.

- These protocols will be explained to students in isolation and quarantine by the Wellness Coordinator and/or designee when they are assigned to their isolation or quarantine room.
- Weekly, the Wellness Coordinator will make arrangements for the medical waste bag to be brought to Capwell Science Hall for proper disposal.
