

## Keystone College COVID-19 Pledge

Students, faculty, and staff at Keystone College agree to help to keep the campus community safe by pledging to abide by the following expectations:

- I PLEDGE to complete daily temperature and symptom checks before coming to campus.
- I PLEDGE to refrain from coming to campus if my temperature is 100 degrees F or above or if I am experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, not related to a pre-existing condition:
  - Fever or chills
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Fatigue
  - Muscle or body aches
  - Headache
  - New loss of taste or smell
  - Sore throat
  - Congestion or runny nose
  - Nausea or vomiting
  - Diarrhea
- I PLEDGE to wear a mask while on campus.
- I PLEDGE to follow social distancing recommendations everywhere on campus.
- I PLEDGE to follow the College's testing, self-isolation, quarantine, and contact tracing protocols before returning to work or class following an illness or suspected encounter with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- In the classroom, WE PLEDGE to:
  - Wear a mask during class and acknowledge that I will be asked to leave if I am not wearing a mask.
  - Sit six feet away from other people.
  - Refrain from eating in classrooms, and only drink a beverage by using a straw while still wearing a mask.
- Additionally, students, faculty and staff agree to abide by the procedures outlined in the College's COVID-19 full reopening plan, which can be viewed [here](#).

These expectations will be monitored by designated students, faculty, and staff who have been trained to guide the campus community through these new, uncharted territories. While it is not the goal for corrective action to be punitive in nature, consistent and blatant unwillingness to comply may result in disciplinary action. Disciplinary action may include removal from on-campus housing, revised scheduling that only includes remote learning options, and possible termination of employment.
