

## **COVID-19 Protocols-Fully Vaccinated Individuals**

In accordance with updated guidance received from the CDC, several campus policies have been updated for fully vaccinated individuals. Fully vaccinated relates to individuals who have had both doses of a two-dose vaccine, or one dose of a single dose vaccine and have completed the 2-week waiting period following their final dose. These individuals are entitled to the following exceptions to the College's existing COVID-19 protocols:

- Currently, all individuals regardless of vaccination status are required to wear face masks inside Keystone College buildings. Face masks are not required in individual residence hall rooms and personal offices, but may be worn if an individual chooses.
- Fully vaccinated individuals do not need to quarantine after an exposure to another person with COVID-19. However, it is still expected that anyone with exposure will participate in contact tracing.
- Fully vaccinated people should be tested 2-5 days following close contact with someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until they receive a negative test result, and isolate if they test positive or develop symptoms.
- Fully vaccinated resident students who have input documentation to the PyraMED health portal will no longer have to participate in surveillance testing during the academic year.
- Policies for fully vaccinated student-athletes related to practice and competition will remain in place while the College monitors recommendations from the NCAA and CSAC.

The fully vaccinated individuals policy also applies to campus visitors.
