

Students not in documented compliance or who are non-exempt with the Keystone College vaccine mandate by Friday, October 29, 2021, will conform to the following restrictions for the remainder of the 2021 calendar year:

- Students will not be allowed to attend classes in-person. Faculty will provide one of the following three options, based on the course requirements and faculty preference:
 - Attend class remotely via Zoom
 - Video recording of lecture with an alternate assignment
 - Alternate assignment with no video recording of the lecture
- Students will not be allowed to visit the Library or attend lab and art studio courses except at the discretion of the faculty affiliated with that facility.
- Students will not be allowed to attend office hours or other consultations with faculty in-person. Students will employ distance technology such as Zoom to meet with faculty.
- Students will be responsible for all required coursework assigned by faculty.
- Students will have limitations regarding participation in other campus activities.
- Residential students will be assigned to either vaccinated and non-vaccinated residence halls/floors.
- Residential students will comply with dining protocols for unvaccinated students.
