

Student Health Requirements

Freshman/Transfer Students

- Emergency Contact and Immunization Form, Insurance form and TB Survey (forms will be available to complete on MyKC for new students one month prior to the start of the semester)
- Access the Student Portal to complete all forms
- Please upload a copy of your Health Insurance Card, Front and Back
- Please complete all forms and Uploads **NO LATER** than **July 15th** for students starting in the fall semester and **NO LATER** than **December 15th** for students starting in the spring semester

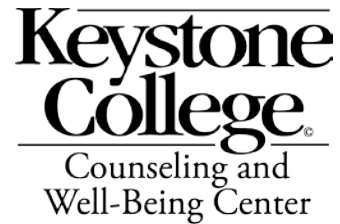
*****If you will be a resident on campus, this MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO MOVING ON CAMPUS*****

- A hard copy of your immunization record should also be submitted to the Student Health Coordinator

Immunization Requirements

- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis, Tetanus, (Tdap) within the last 10 years
- Meningococcal Meningitis A,C,Y,W-135
 - If first dose was prior to age 16, a second dose is required

Pennsylvania State law requires all college students to receive information about meningitis/meningococcal disease and the vaccine, and to either receive the vaccine before coming to college or sign a waiver.



Student Health Portal

- Students who are registered for classes will have access to the Student Health Portal up to 30 days prior to the start of classes.
- The Student Health Portal can be accessed from MyKC or the Keystone College Health Services page.
- You will use the same username and password as your Keystone email and MyKC.
- Complete and submit all forms (please note some have a time limit of 15 minutes, please save your information periodically).
- Vaccinations **MUST** be entered into the portal manually. They can **NOT** be uploaded.
- **Athletes** who turn in vaccination forms to the athletic department, **MUST** still complete the information in the Student Health Portal
- Click 'document upload' and upload your insurance card
